

ADMISSION BY KARL HAU.

Purchased a False Beard—Accused Man Pleads His Own Case.

FRANKFORT, Germany, Feb. 1.—Prof. Karl Hau of George Washington University, who is charged with the murder of his mother-in-law, was brought here from Karlsruhe yesterday by two policemen and confronted with various persons who had seen him in Frankfort, where he bought a false beard. They all recognized the prisoner, who admitted having purchased the beard and agreed with the statements regarding his other alleged acts and movements in Frankfort, but he continued to deny that he killed his mother-in-law, Frau Molitor.

Hau pleaded his own case and questioned the witnesses in a very clever manner. When the official confrontation was ended the prisoner was taken back to Karlsruhe.
